OBJECTIVE

Protectoseal Series 53300 Emergency Pressure Manhole Cover Vents provide emergency pressure relief for storage tanks as well as convenient access for tank cleaning, inspection and repair work. They are designed for installation on the manhole opening of tank and provide a means of relieving large volumes of vapors, beyond the capacity of a normal operating vent, if an emergency fire involvement of the tank should occur. Series 53300 Manhole Covers do not provide vacuum relief. Vacuum relief must be supplied by operating vents such as Protectoseal Series 830, 8540, 6240, 16240 and 18540. Series 52500 Manway Cover Vents provide pressure and vacuum relief.

TECHNIQUE

When positioned on the flanged seat, the Series 53300 Emergency Pressure Manhole Cover Vent provides an effective vapor-tight seal. Under emergency fire conditions, the cover opens fully to allow escape of vapors and prevent damage to the tank due to excessive pressure. The cover is tethered to the tank flange by a cable and must be manually repositioned after venting has occurred. The webs on the bottom of the cover insure proper guiding and positioning of the cover on the seat.

SPECIAL FEATURES

Fast Inspection, Easy Maintenance. The design allows convenient access through the manhole opening for tank inspection and repair procedures. All parts are easily accessible for inspection, removal and replacement. A retaining cable prevents loss of cover.

Maintains Accurate Pressure Settings. Set points are accurate to within +/- 3% across the entire range of available pressure relief settings shown in the chart on the reverse. Set point accuracy is assured by stringent machining, assembly and test procedures. Higher settings are available upon special request, but may require longer lead times,

Air-Cushioned Seating. A flat, smooth diaphragm of FEP film is supported on both sides of an annular channel to form a floating air seal with the seat. An outer support rim assures proper seating.

Low-Leak Covers. Leakage on vent covers is no more than 1 SCFH at 90% of the set pressure.

Sizes Available. Available in 16" (DN 400) through 24" (DN 600) sizes. Flanged to mate with standard flanged 150# ANSI, API (20" or 24" only) or DIN PN 16 bolting specifications. Other drilling patterns are also available upon special request.


